Privacy Policy

At Gastronomy.space we are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how we use cookies and similar technologies. This Privacy Policy is an integral part of our Terms, the defined terms in this Policy have the same meaning as in our Terms.

For the purposes of data protection laws, the data controller is LLC GO BEAUTY STUDIOS OFFICES, a company, whose registered agrees is located at 02125, Ukraine, Kyiv, Perova Boulevard 10-A, office 170.

1. What information do we collect?

It is not necessary to provide us with your personal data to use the Website, so we do not collect personal data in connection with the operation of our Website.

When you visit our Website, our servers automatically record information that your browser sends whenever you visit a website ("**Log Data**"). This Log Data may include information such as your IP address, browser type, or the domain from which you are visiting. For most users accessing the Internet from an Internet service provider, the IP address will be different every time you log on. We use Log Data only for the technical administration of the Website.

If you contact us at info@gastronomy.space, we may keep a record of your contact information and correspondence and may use your email address, and any information that you provide to us in your message, to respond to you.

Like many websites, we also use cookies and similar technologies to collect additional usage data to improve our Website and the content offered via the Website.

2. What are cookies?

Cookies are small files comprising bits of text that are installed on your computer or mobile device each time you open the Website. These small files enable our server to remember some information about your activity on the Website, record information about your online preferences, and help us to tailor our Website to your needs and interests.

The cookies will collect information relating to your use of our Website, information about your device, e.g. the device's IP address and browser type, broad location, the URL that referred you to our Website, browsing activity, content or ads viewed and clicked, dates and times of access, pages viewed, and other Website usage activity. The information provided by cookies can help us to analyse your use of our Website and help us to provide you with a better user experience.

Cookies also enable behavioral advertising. That means that they provide an opportunity for you to see relevant ads of, for example, some products and services that you have recently searched for.

3. Which cookies do we use?

The Company uses the following types of cookies:

Type	Description
Performance or 'Strictly Necessary' Cookies	These cookies ensure the secure and optimal function of the Website. These cookies do not track where you have been on the internet and do not remember preferences and do not gather information about you that could be used for marketing purposes. You cannot opt out of these cookies, as they are essential for the running of our Website.
Functionality Cookies	These cookies are used to remember your preferences on our Website and to provide enhanced, more personal features. The information collected by these cookies is usually anonymised, so we cannot identify you personally. Functional cookies are not essential for the Website's performance, but they make it more user-friendly.
Analytical Cookies	These cookies are used to monitor the performance of our Website, for example, to determine the number of page views and the number of unique users. We engage trusted third parties, such as Google Analytics, to analyse patterns of user behaviour and we use that information to enhance user experience. The information is anonymous (i.e., it cannot be used to identify you and does not contain personal information such as your name and email address) and it is only used for statistical purposes.
Targeting or 'Behavioural Advertising' Cookies	These cookies, which may be placed on your device by us or our trusted third-party service providers, remember that you have visited a website and use that information to provide you with content or advertising which is tailored to your interests. This is often called online behavioural advertising and is done by grouping together shared interests based upon web browsing history. Your web browsing history can be used to infer things about you (e.g., your age, gender etc.), and this information may also be used to make advertising on websites more relevant to you.

4. How do we deal with data collected through the cookies?

If you visited our Website, the cookies consent message was the first message that you were likely to see that prompted you about the fact that cookies are used and active on our Website. In most cases, we ask you for your consent to install cookies. This does not apply only to the strictly needed cookies.

We together with our trusted partners use cookies for a number of purposes, as defined below.

Performance and Functional Cookies. We use these cookies to enable certain online functionality, remember the last page you visited on the Website, identify returning users, provide them with a personalised version of the Website, as well as enable commenting on our Website.

Analytical Cookies. We use these cookies to measure users' behaviour and improve our Website. By using analytics services provided by third parties such as Google Analytics, we can analyse which pages are viewed and how long, and which links are followed, and we can use this information to provide more content that is of interest.

Targeting or ‘Behavioural Advertising’ Cookies. We use these cookies to deliver content tailored to your interests, display relevant advertising to you, as well as to build a profile based on information from your visit so that we and third parties can target advertising to users that will be more relevant to their interests.

In addition, we use these cookies to manage online advertising and revenue share arrangements. Our approved advertising partners, namely Google (Google DoubleClick and AdSense) use cookies to provide advertising to you and to enable us to manage our relationship with those advertisers by, for example, tracking how many unique users have seen a particular advertisement, visited a particular page of the Website or followed a link in an advertisement.

5. How do we share collected information?

Contractors and Partners. The Company has contractors in other countries, including those outside the European Economic Area. Your information may be accessed by our contractors in Ukraine. The transfer of your personal data to recipients in other countries is secured by the Standard data protection clauses adopted by the European Commission and compliant with the EU data protection laws.

Third-Party Advertisers. We use third-party advertising companies to display relevant ads when you visit our Website. These companies will collect certain information from your use of this and other websites in order to provide advertisements about goods and services of interest to you. This information will not include data that directly identifies you, such as your name, email address, address, or phone number.

These third-party advertising companies include Google Analytics, Google DoubleClick and Google AdSense. This Privacy Policy does not govern the use of cookies or other tracking by such third parties. For Legal Purposes. We reserve the right to disclose your information in order to comply with the law, applicable regulations and government requests, or to detect, prevent, or otherwise address illegal or suspected illegal activities, security or technical issues. We also reserve the right to use such information to protect against harm to the rights, property or safety of the Company, our operating systems, users or the public, as required or permitted by law.

In all cases when we transfer your information to other persons, we are confident that your information is protected and used only for the purposes specified in this Privacy Policy. We achieve such safety by using only certified services and products, signing agreements on protection of personal data with contractors and partners, as well as taking technical measures to ensure the data is protected when stored and used, and also while being processed and transferred.

6. Can I manage or opt-out of cookies?

Yes, cookies can be deleted from your hard drive. You can also change the preferences/settings in your browser to control cookies. Some internet browsers have a ‘Do Not Track or ‘DNT’ setting, known as Global Privacy Control; this sends a signal to websites asking them not to track your browsing. 8. Data retention

We store the data collected with the use of cookies until you stop using the Website. At the end of this period, we make all such data anonymous and store it only for statistical purposes.

9. Security

We implement appropriate administrative, technical and security safeguards to help prevent unauthorized access, use, or disclosure of the information we collect. However, no systems can be completely secure. Therefore, while we use reasonable efforts to protect your information, we cannot guarantee its absolute security, and your use of the Website indicates your agreement to assume this risk.

10. Children's Policy

The Website is not designed or intended for use by children under the age of 16. If we become aware that a child under 16 has provided us with personal data without the parent's/guardian's permission to use our Website, we will remove such information from our files.

11. Changes to This Privacy Policy
